



HOSA STUDENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Definitions

- a) The term “**Electronic Property**” is used to refer, collectively, to:
 - i. HOSA Canada’s electronic resources
 - ii. HOSA Canada’s student Portal
 - iii. Test questions/answers from competitive events offered by HOSA Canada
- b) The term “**HOSA student**” means those students that have paid the required Registration Fee (defined below) and joined HOSA Canada.

2. HOSA Student

- a) During the Annual Term, the HOSA student has access to:
 - i. HOSA Canada’s Electronic Property by way of a secure login; and
 - ii. conferences offered by HOSA Canada and National HOSA.
- b) The HOSA student may apply for scholarship opportunities offered by National HOSA or HOSA Canada.

3. Registration Fee

- a) A fee of \$35 (the “**Registration Fee**”) must be paid in full by the student within two months of completion of the Chapter Registration Form.
- b) The Registration Fee is nonrefundable, nontransferable and nonexchangeable and cannot be changed or altered by HOSA Canada during the HOSA student Term.
- c) HOSA Canada is not responsible for the costs of any conferences attended by the HOSA student or the materials provided at such conferences. For greater certainty, participation in conferences will be at the HOSA student’s own expense.

4. HOSA Student Term

- a) HOSA student term in HOSA Canada is effective upon payment of the Registration Fee until July 1 of the year following payment of the Registration Fee (the “**HOSA Student Term**”).

5. Data and Information

- a) All contact information collected from the HOSA student will be confidential.
- b) The HOSA student's competitive results will be used for analysis or shared with a third party.
- c) HOSA Canada is not allowed to tamper or alter any of the data submitted by the HOSA student.
- d) The HOSA student must submit correct information to the best of their abilities.

6. Electronic Property

- a) The HOSA student shall not recreate, copy, share, or publish any of HOSA Canada's Electronic Property.
 - b) The HOSA student shall use HOSA Canada's Electronic Property for Personal and Educational Use only.
 - c) HOSA Canada does not make any representations or warranties, actual or implied, as to the accuracy of the Electronic Property (including the material contained in the student portal) or its fitness for a particular purpose.
