

HOSA Canada 2021-2022

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Registration

Registration for The Fall Leadership Conference (Virtual) and The Spring Leadership Conference (Hybrid Format) will follow the same process as the 2020-2021 school year.

Registration will open on **September 8, 2021**.

Register your account:

1. Go to our registration page by typing shop.hosacanada.org into your browser or click [here](#).
2. Click **"Create account"** underneath the "Sign In" button.
3. Complete the registration form. Here are some important things to keep in mind when completing the form:
 - If your school is not included in the drop-down menu, select "Other", and in the field below, write your school's name with the correct spelling
 - Do not add abbreviations to the school's name, unless that is the official name of the school, ex. If your school is University of Toronto - Mississauga, do not simply write UTM
 - For the field that asks for your competitive event, make sure to visit the competitive events page on our website for a complete list of competitive events offered by HOSA Canada
 - This is the event you will be competing in at the conference
 - Please double check that your name and email address are spelled correctly, as we only communicate with students through the email they provided
 - **For Post-Secondary Students:**
 - You can only compete in one of the following listed events:
 - Medical Terminology
 - Pathophysiology
 - HOSA Bowl
 - Forensic Science
 - Biomedical Debate
 - Public Health
 - Sports Medicine
 - Biomedical Laboratory Science
 - Pharmacology
 - Dental Science
 - Medical Math
 - Emergency Medical Technician
 - Clinical Nursing
 - Veterinary Science
 - If you select an event that is not included in list, and do not change it prior to the event change deadline, we will automatically enrol you in one of the listed events

4. If you are unsure of your event and teammates, you can change them up until the conference registration deadline.
 - If you register for a team event, you must have the correct number of teammates who are registered and paid by the registration deadline, or we will enrol you in an individual event
 - Please ensure that the names and emails of your teammates are indicated correctly
5. Upon completion of the form, click "Create Account". If you have filled in all the fields correctly, you will get a notification email and you will be taken to our Store.

Purchase your membership and conference admissions

Students can purchase one of three items: HOSA Canada Membership, Conference Admission, or the combined Membership and Conference Package

- Students must pay the membership fee before purchasing the conference admission.
- A detailed description of what each package offers can be found on their respective product pages at shop.hosacanada.org.
- Only one membership and one conference admission can be purchased for an account on shop.hosacanada.org.
 - If two students from the same household or school want to purchase a membership/conference package, they must do so with separate accounts.
 - The name on the account must match the name of the student
 - The only place the name can be different when purchasing these items is under the billing address, if the card is not your own
 - Ex. If a parent is purchasing the membership for the student, the student still must create their own account on shop.hosacanada.org, then when you check out your cart, enter the student's name in all applicable fields, except under the billing address field

Access your Resources and How to Edit your Information

This year HOSA Canada will be transitioning from ACTO to Google Classroom. An invite link will be sent to you within 7 business days from when you register and pay.

You can check if we have sent you the link by going to "My Account" on shop.hosacanada.org and checking "Fulfillment Status". If it says unfulfilled, we have not sent the link. If it says fulfilled, we have sent the link. If it says fulfilled and you did not get a link, please email us at info@hosacanada.org, but make sure to check your spam folder for the link as well.

Editing your Account Details (Changing your event/teammate information)

To edit your account, go to the “My Account” page by clicking the person icon on the top right.

Click on the “Edit Account” button to access your account information. You can update any of the information fields here including your competitive event and your teammates.

If you choose to change your competitive event and teammate information, make sure to do so, before the event change deadline.

The Fall Leadership Conference (FLC)

The 2021 Fall Leadership Conference will be held via an online testing platform. FLC will be taking place from **November 20 - November 26**.

FLC is an opportunity for you to showcase your preparation and see where you rank amongst your peers. It is not a qualifier conference, if you choose to not compete, you can still compete at SLC, however the conference fee will remain the same.

If your event has a written test portion: You will only be writing the test, there will not be a round 2.

- You will have the entire week to write the test, however once you start it, there is a time limit

If your event does not have a written test portion: You will either be submitting your round 1 submission, or you will have a presentation component

- The event guidelines indicate whether your event has a test, presentation, submission, and the number of rounds
- Presentations will take place **November 20 and November 21**, and specific times will be announced closer to the conference
- The submission deadline will be **November 19 at 11:59 PM**

The FLC registration/event change/teammate information deadline is **November 13 at 11:59 PM**.

The Spring Leadership Conference (SLC)

The Spring Leadership Conference is our highlight conference, where students compete for a place at the International Leadership conference.

SLC 2022 will be taking place tentatively in the **first week of May**, depending on the state of the pandemic.

It will follow a Hybrid-format with both online and in-person components.

Written tests, for events that have one, will be administered **April 17 to April 23**, students will have one week to complete their test, similar to FLC 2020 and SLC 2021.

The submission deadline, for events that have a submission portion, will be **April 30th, 2022 at 11:59 PM.**

If your event has a round 2 component and you live within 150 km of the conference venue, you will be expected to complete round 2 in-person, otherwise you will complete it online similar to SLC 2021.

The conference venue will be in downtown Toronto.

The SLC registration/event change/teammate information deadline is **April 16 at 11:59 PM.**

Workshops will be administered online and in-person (for those that live within 150 km of the conference venue).

If you would like to attend an in-person workshop, but don't live within 150 km, we will have a select number of spots available.

Workshop details and registration information will be announced closer to the conference.

Bi-Weekly Health Professional Series

This year we have introduced our Bi-weekly Health Professional Series that will be running throughout the year, starting in late September.

These workshops will be highlighting various disciplines within the healthcare field and will be held on a bi-weekly basis.

- Examples of workshops include Paths to Med, Dentistry, Veterinary Science, and more!

These workshops will be held online via Zoom, similar to the SLC 2021 workshops.

The first health professional series workshop will be open to all students, even those who have not yet paid the conference fee. After that only HOSA Canada members who have paid the conference fee will be accommodated.

Monthly Competitive Events Workshop

We are also introducing Monthly Competitive Events Workshops.

All HOSA Canada members who have paid the conference fee will be accommodated.

Within 7 business days after you have registered and paid the membership fee, you will receive an email invitation to the email that was used to register, inviting you to “Join” a class.

 - You will be able to access a classroom for the competitive event you register for, as well as a general Classroom for general updates and reminders.
